It is a positive space where we meet to socialise and get engaged in activities such as playing skittles, doing puzzles, or drawing, if that is what you want to do. Coffee, tea and cakes are available for a donation. We're meeting every first Monday of the month at 2-3:30pm, starting 3 November. Though it is run by the church, and our motivation to run the Social is faith-based, we are open to all faiths and none. And if you can play the piano, this is a great chance to practise and spread joy!

In the words of the wonderful poet Maya Angelou: "I've learned that people will forget what you said, people will forget what you did, but people will never forget how you made them feel." Sunshine Social is a space where you can unwind and recharge among friends, and hopefully leave feeling happy and loved.

16 November: This is Cathedral Music Trust's Celebration Sunday, a day when we celebrate the Church Choir Award of £3,000 we have received for the purpose of supporting and developing our Song School activities, and give thanks for the generosity of the Trust's donors who make such awards possible.
